

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE CODE
OF THE BOROUGH OF RUMSON BY
AMENDING CHAPTER III
POLICE REGULATIONS

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Rumson, in the County of Monmouth and State of New Jersey, that the General Ordinances be amended as follows (*new text is double underlined, text to be deleted is struck through*):

SECTION 1

That General Ordinances Chapter III, Police Regulations, Section 3-2, Disorderly Persons be amended to read as follows:

CHAPTER III

POLICE REGULATIONS

3-2 DISORDERLY PERSONS.

3-2.1 Nudity and Indecent Behavior. through 3-2.20 Disturbing Libraries or Reading Rooms.

3-2.21 ~~Intoxication: Street and Highway Public Consumption of Alcoholic Beverages.~~

~~a. No person shall, within the limits of the borough, be intoxicated or drunk and disorderly to the annoyance of any person or persons.~~

~~b. No person shall serve, sell, dispense, drink, consume or retain or have in his or her possession in any open container any alcoholic beverage on a public street, highway, avenue, alley or road of the borough, or upon any public grounds, parks, sidewalks, beaches, marine basins, beachfronts, or boardwalks in the borough, or in any automobile, other vehicle or in any other means of transportation on the public streets, highways, alleys, avenues, grounds, sidewalks, beaches, parks, marine basins, beachfronts, or boardwalks in the borough, except as stated in Section 10-1.2(g) of the General Ordinances of the Borough of Rumson.~~

3-2.22 Permit Required for Public Address or Sound System. through 3-2.38 Payment of Fines.

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage and publication according to law.
