

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF RUMSON
BY AMENDING CHAPTER VII, TRAFFIC ORDINANCE

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Rumson, in the County of Monmouth and State of New Jersey that Chapter VII, (Traffic), Section 7-3 Parking to add Section 7-3.9 Designation of Handicapped Parking Spaces and Schedule IB Handicapped Parking Spaces on the Street and in Municipal Parking Lots of the General Ordinances of the Borough of Rumson is hereby amended or supplemented as follows:

PURPOSE

The purpose of this ordinance is to Amend Chapter VII (Traffic), Section 7-3 and to add Schedule IB Handicapped Parking on the Street and Municipal Parking Lots.

Chapter VII (Traffic), Section 7-3 Parking and Schedule IB Handicapped Parking Spaces on the Street and in Municipal Parking Lots of the General Ordinances of the Borough of Rumson are hereby amended or supplemented as follows (new text is double underlined, text to be deleted is struck through and notations to the reader and changes in subparagraph designations either with or without changes to content are italicized):

SECTION 1.

That Chapter VII, Traffic Ordinance, Section 7-3 Parking be supplemented as follows:

7-3 PARKING.

7-3.1 Regulations Not Exclusive. through 7-3.8 Parking Restricted on Wilson Circle.

No Change.

7-3.9 Regulations of Handicapped Parking Spaces on the Street and in Municipal Parking Lots.

a. **DEFINITIONS.** The following definitions shall apply to the provisions of subsection 7-3.9:

Handicapped parking spaces shall mean a parking space on the street or within a parking yard or parking place which are open to the public or to which the public is invited, whether maintained or operated separately or in conjunction with any business enterprise, and which is designated by suitable signs as being reserved for parking by a handicapped person only and which has been approved by the Planning Board of the Borough of Rumson.

Handicapped person shall mean any person who qualifies under the provision of N.J.S.A. 39:204 and who possesses a special vehicle identification by the State of New Jersey Motor Vehicle Commission, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 39:4-205, or by a similar body in another state when such motor vehicle is properly identified pursuant to N.J.S.A. 39:4-206 by a registration plate bearing the national wheelchair symbol, or properly identified pursuant to the laws of another state, or displaying a temporary handicapped placard issued by the Chief of Police.

b. *It shall be unlawful for any person to park, stop or stand a motor vehicle in any parking space designated for the exclusive use of handicapped persons, unless such person is a handicapped person or is transporting a handicapped person and is utilizing the handicapped parking space for the benefit of such handicapped person.*

c. *In accordance with the provisions of N.J.S.A. 39:4-107, 39:4-202, 39:4-183.27 and 30:4-198, on-street locations as shown in Schedule IB, §7-3.9, attached to and made a part of this chapter, are designated as handicapped parking spaces. Such spaces are for use by persons who have been issued special identification cards for plates or placards by the State of New Jersey Motor Vehicle Commission, or a temporary placard issued by the Chief of Police. No other person shall be permitted to park in these spaces.*

SECTION 2.

That Chapter VII, Traffic Ordinance, Section 7-3 Parking Schedule IB be added as follows:

SCHEDULE IB

HANDICAPPED PARKING ON THE STREET

In accordance with provisions of subsection 7-3.9, no person shall park a vehicle in a designated handicapped parking space on the street unless special identification cards or placards issued by the State of New Jersey Motor Vehicle Commission, or a temporary placard issued by the Chief of Police, is displayed.

SECTION 3.

If any section, subsection, clause, or phrase of this ordinance is held to be unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, such decision shall not affect the remaining portions of this ordinance. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

SECTION 4.

This ordinance shall take effect upon final passage and publication according to law.
