

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE CODE OF THE  
BOROUGH OF RUMSON BY AMENDING  
CHAPTER II-ADMINISTRATION AND  
CHAPTER XVI-ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Rumson, in the County of Monmouth and State of New Jersey that Chapter II (Administration) and Chapter XVI (Environmental Protection) of the General Ordinances of the Borough of Rumson is hereby amended or supplemented as follows:

**PURPOSE**

The purpose of this Ordinance is to Amend Chapter II (Administration) to amend the Powers and Duties of Special Law Enforcement Officers to include Class III Officers and to Amend Chapter XVI (Environmental Protection) to update the requirements for the Site Development Stormwater Plan.

*Chapter II (Administrative), Section 2-11 Special Police Officers and Chapter XVI (Environmental Protection), Section 16-2 Stormwater Management and Control of the General Ordinances of the Borough of Rumson are hereby amended or supplemented as follows (new text is double underlined, text to be deleted is ~~struck through~~ and notations to the reader and changes in subparagraph designations either with or without changes to content are italicized):*

**SECTION 1.**

That Chapter II, Administration, shall be amended to as follows:

**CHAPTER II  
ADMINISTRATION**

**2-1 CHAPTER TITLE through 2-10 BOARD OF HEALTH.**

**2-11 POLICE DEPARTMENT.**

**2-11.1 Definitions through 2-11.13 Qualifications.**

No Changes.

**2-11.14 Special Police Officers.**

The Mayor and Council of the Borough of Rumson may appoint from time to time special law enforcement officers in accordance with New Jersey State Statutes for terms not exceeding one (1) year.

*a. Powers and Duties of Special III Police Officers.*

1. Special Law Enforcement Class III Police Officers will be assigned to roles within the department as consistent with New Jersey and the restrictions of the Special Law Enforcement Class III Officers.

2. A Special Law Enforcement Class III Police Officers shall be employed only to assist the Police Department with security duties at public/private schools.

3. Special Law Enforcement Class III Police Officers shall be authorized to exercise full powers and duties similar to those of a permanent, regularly appointed full-time police officer while providing security at a public or nonpublic on the school premises during hours when the public or nonpublic school is normally in session or when it is occupied by public or nonpublic students or their teachers.

4. Special Law Enforcement Class III Police Officers will act under the supervision of a Patrolman or above and will only utilize police powers consistent with their certification restrictions.

5. A Special Law Enforcement Class III Police Officer appointed shall not, based on this appointment, be eligible for health care benefits or enrollment in any state-administered retirement system.

~~a.~~ b. *Powers and Duties of Special II Police Officers.*

1. Special II Police Officers will be assigned to roles within the department as consistent with New Jersey Law and the restrictions of the Special II certification.

2. When assigned to patrol or where otherwise applicable, Special II Officers will be vested with the powers and responsibilities of Patrolman. Such power and responsibility will only be vested during the time period assigned and authorized.

3. Special II Officers will act under the supervision of a Patrolman or above and will only utilize police powers consistent with their certification restrictions.

4. Special II Officers will seek authorized approval from a supervising officer for all significant police action, such as arrest, if time allows.

b. c. *Powers and Duties of Special I Police Officers.*

1. Special I Officers will be assigned to roles within the department as consistent with New Jersey Law and the restrictions of the Special I certification.

2. Special I Officers will act under the supervision of a Patrolman or above and will only utilize police powers consistent with their certification restrictions.

3. At no time will Special I Officers take significant police action without approval.

c. d. *Powers and Duties of Dispatchers.*

1. Dispatchers will have no police powers.

2. Dispatchers will be responsible for the timely and appropriate answering and prioritization of incoming phone calls and requests. Non emergent calls will be routed or referred in an appropriate manner.

3. Dispatchers will be responsible for the timely and appropriate dispatching of all necessary emergency services, including: Police, Fire and First Aid and mutual aid.

4. Dispatchers will route requests for services made by non emergent sources such as the Department of Public Works and Wastewater Management. Additionally, notifications will be made to these sources when their service is required.

5. Dispatchers are responsible for appropriately documenting all calls for service.

6. Dispatchers will be responsible for adhering to all applicable rules, regulations and procedures including but not limited to: uniform and appearance, use of chain of command, obeying orders, reporting times and demeanor.

9. Major Development Stormwater Summary “Attachment D”

(a) For applications to the NJDEP for structural and non-structural Stormwater measures, the applicant’s engineer shall submit a Major Development Stormwater Summary “Attachment D” to the Borough Engineer. The form can be found at [https://www.nj.gov/dep/dwg/pdf/Tier\\_A/Tier\\_A\\_Attachment\\_D\\_Major\\_Development\\_Summary\\_Fill\\_In.pdf](https://www.nj.gov/dep/dwg/pdf/Tier_A/Tier_A_Attachment_D_Major_Development_Summary_Fill_In.pdf). A final Major Development Stormwater Summary shall be submitted by the applicant’s engineer to the Borough Engineer as a condition of the issuance of a certificate of occupancy.

**16-2.11 Stormwater Management Requirements for Other Than Major Development through 16-2.13 Violations and Penalties.**

**16-3 YARD WASTE COLLECTION PROGRAM through 16-11 PRIVATE STORM DRAIN INLET RETROFITTING.**

**SECTION 3.**

If any section, subsection, clause, or phrase of this ordinance is held to be unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, such decision shall not affect the remaining portions of this ordinance. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

This ordinance shall take effect upon final passage and publication according to law.
