PAPER & CARDBOARD: Corrugated cardboard boxes, paper cartons, cereal & frozen food boxes, newspaper, magazines & catalogs, mail, mixed paper, phone books, etc.-CLEANED & FLATTENED



PLASTIC: All plastic containers labeled #1, #2 or #5 with caps removed
CLEAN CONTAINERS ONLY



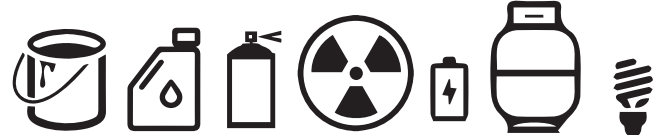
METAL & GLASS: Glass jars & bottles with caps removed, metal food cans and aluminum cans CLEAN CONTAINERS ONLY

CAPS & LIDS CAN BE RECYCLED IF SEPARATED FROM CONTAINERS

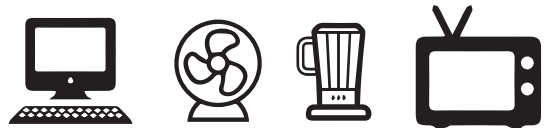

DONATE INSTEAD: Many items can be donated instead of being sent to landfill. See website for local organizations and other options.



HAZARDOUS ITEMS: All hazardous waste containers and items must be taken to Monmouth County Recycling Facility in Tinton Falls. Stores such as Home Depot will take CFL lightbulbs and propane tanks.



APPLIANCES, TV SETS & COMPUTER EQUIPMENT can now be recycled as part of a scheduled Wednesday bulk pick-up and Borough Green Day.



PLASTIC BAGS & STYROFOAM cannot be recycled at Rumson DPW or curbside, please see website for dropoff locations.

NON-CFL LIGHTBULBS, PLASTIC FLOWER POTS & SOME ALKALINE HOUSEHOLD BATTERIES should be discarded in trash.

DO NOT BAG YOUR RECYCLING: Plastic bags clog the equipment and are not recyclable through the curbside pick-up or town recycling center. Instead take them to drop-off boxes local grocery stores such as ACME, Foodtown, Shoprite & Whole Foods.

RECYCLING CENTER DROP-OFF

The Recycling Center is located behind Rumson Borough Hall at the foot of Avenue of Two Rivers, next to the municipal boat ramp.

DROP-OFF HOURS

7 AM - Dusk Monday through Friday
9 AM - 3 PM Weekends and Holidays

*The center is CLOSED on the following holidays:
New Year's Day, Easter Sunday, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day, and Christmas Day.

CURBSIDE RECYCLING PICK-UP

Curbside pick-up is available to all residents twice monthly. Both residents and businesses should have their items at the curb no later than 7:00 AM on designated days to ensure pick-up.

MONTHLY PICK-UP SCHEDULE

1st & 3rd Wednesday: East of Bingham Avenue
2nd & 4th Wednesday: Bingham Avenue & West

*except holidays when recycling center is closed
