## Chapter 9. Sewer and Water

### § 9-1.7. Connections Prohibited.

[Ord. 8/13/64; Ord. 10/15/98, § 1; Ord. No. 08-016G, § 1; Ord. No. 18-015G § 4]

No owner, occupant, or tenant of residential, educational, religious, commercial, or industrial properties situated in the Borough of Rumson, or any plumbing contractor hired by same, shall connect or maintain the connection or permit to be connected or permit the maintenance of the connection of drain water, sump pumps, roof leaders, roof drains, swimming pools, ornamental ponds, water cooled refrigeration, air conditioning units, fire sprinkler systems, and any other similar devices with the Borough of Rumson's and/or the Two Rivers Water Reclamation Authority's sanitary sewer system.

## Chapter 19. Water and Sewer

### § 19-2.7. Certain Connection Prohibited.

[2002 Code § 13.08.070]

No owner, occupant, or tenant of residential, educational, religious, commercial, or industrial properties shall connect or maintain the connection or permit to be connected or permit the maintenance of the connection of any sump pumps, roof leaders, roof drains, swimming pools, ornamental ponds, water cooled refrigeration, air-conditioning units, fire sprinkler systems, and any other similar devices with the Borough of Fair Haven or Two Rivers Water Reclamation Authority's sanitary sewer system.

## Chapter 12. Buildings and Housing; Soil Removal

### § 12-9.1. Connections.

No owner, occupant, or tenant of residential, educational, religious, commercial, or industrial properties situated in the Borough of Little Silver shall connect or maintain the connection or permit to be connected or permit the maintenance of the connection of any sump pumps, roof leaders, roof drains, swimming pools, ornamental ponds, water cooled refrigeration, air conditioning units, fire sprinkler systems, and any other similar devices with the Northeast Monmouth County Regional Sewerage Authority's sanitary sewer system.
