# **Rumson Recreation Field Permit Guidelines**

- Anyone requesting a field must complete the Field Users Permit Request Form and attach a certificate of insurance. This must be submitted to the Rumson Recreation Director.
- No glass bottles on any field. Aluminum cans and plastic bottles are permitted; however, they must be recycled properly.
- All garbage should be cleaned off the field and inside the dugouts.
- During any tournament all trash must be placed in plastic bags (provided by the tournament) and left next to the garbage can for pick up by the borough.
- During tournaments the tournament director should appoint someone to monitor the bathrooms.
- No vehicles (ie. tractors) are permitted on any field to drag or prepare the field.
- Adhere to the designated time slot to allow for the next team scheduled to play.
- Damage or potential liability must be reported to the Recreation Director immediately.
- No dogs are permitted in the park.

#### Baseball/Softball specific guidelines

- When using a rake to prepare the field, do not rake the clay/dirt onto any grass area.
- Rakes are for raking out and smoothing footprints only, not for removing water or mud. Fields should not be played on if muddy or if there is standing water.
- No soft toss (throwing the ball in the air and hitting it into the backstop).
- Put all bases etc. back into the field box and lock the field box.
